

**Sr. Frances O'Dell, OSF**  
**December 10, 1947 – June 5, 2026**

**Sister Frances O'Dell was born and named Rae Elizabeth O'Dell on December 10, 1947, in Poughkeepsie, NY. She peacefully entered eternal life on June 5, 2026, at St. Elizabeth Motherhouse in Allegany, NY. Frances was the daughter of Raymond and Elizabeth (Deyo) O'Dell.**

**On September 8, 1965, Rae entered the Franciscan Sisters of Allegany; was received into the Congregation on July 2, 1966, receiving the name, Sr. M. Francis Stephen, OSF; and professed her final religious vows on September 8, 1973. Committed to the Franciscan Mission and Charism for over 60 years, Sister Frances shared her life, gifts and talents within the community and beyond with all whom she came in contact. She simply enjoyed sharing her Franciscan spirit!**

**Due to her father's employment as a Federal Park Ranger, Frances moved to several locations in her early years; therefore, she attended many elementary schools. Her last 6 years of junior/senior high school were in Homestead, Fla. where she graduated from South Dade Sr High School in 1965. It was here in Homestead that she met the Allegany Franciscans when she attended Religious Education classes. Upon entering the FSA, she pursued a BS in Elementary Education with a minor in History from St. Bonaventure University. In 1978, she was awarded an MA in Sacred Science, also, from St. Bonaventure University.**

**For over 20 years, Sister's main ministry was in the field of education both in the USA and Jamaica. In 1993, she redirected her gifts and talents as a certified reference librarian at Barry College in Miami, FL. It was here that she interfaced with many young men and women searching for needed educational information, however, she also touched many of their lives by sharing her faith, joy and love of all creation. She simply lived the Gospel!**

**While in Jamaica, she extended her time, energy and enthusiasm to "The Girl Guides Association of JA". It was with Pat Shirley and Angela Harris (RIP) that Frances empowered young women through leadership, life skills and outdoor activities through this organization. She was her happiest when she**

**was sharing her deep love for creation and the Creator. Frances was a true follower of St. Francis!**

**In 2016, Fran was warmly welcomed home to St. Elizabeth Motherhouse in Allegany, NY where she has enjoyed the company of her Sisters. During this time, she volunteered in the Archives where she worked side by side with Ellen Winger, our Archivist. She relished delving into documents, writings, biographies etc. and sharing historical “tidbits” with the other Sisters. Frances leaves in the Archives a 25-page document titled *The Allegany Franciscan Experience: Considerations on Our Charism*.**

**Sister Frances is predeceased by her parents, Raymond and Elizabeth O’Dell. She is survived by a brother, Steven and his wife, Denise.**
